Re: Cascades Canada. – Public Hearing Decision

The department received public comments for your application for an Environment Act Licence to continue operation of a corrugated and boxboard manufacturing facility at 680 Wall Street in the City of Winnipeg.

Public comments include concerns on zoning, Volatile Organic Compounds and Hazardous Air Pollutants emission, public health, proximity to residents, traffic, and wastewater discharge. A team of provincial technical experts also reviewed and commented on the application. The branch sent the comments to you for information and response. The next step is to determine if the Clean Environment Commission (CEC) needs to conduct a public hearing. At this time, I am not recommending a CEC public hearing to the Minister of Environment and Climate Change.
