

# Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Manitoba Environment and Climate invites public comment on the following proposal:

## **City of Brandon – Water Treatment Facility Upgrades – FILE: 6180.00**

The City of Brandon proposes upgrades to its water treatment facility located at 108 26<sup>th</sup> Street North. The upgrades include a new water intake on the Assiniboine River northwest of the water treatment facility, two raw water storage cells, a dual train membrane treatment process to supplement the existing treatment process, and related upgrades to the existing facilities. The expanded capacity of the water treatment system would be 50.2 million litres per day, sufficient to meet the City's maximum daily water demand until 2048. Construction of the upgrades would extend from mid-2023 to the end of 2026.
