

Notice of Environment Act Proposal

Manitoba Environment and Climate Change invites public comment on the following proposal:

**MANITOBA TRANSPORTATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE (MTI) - PTH 5
ASSINIBOINE RIVER BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND FLOOD RELIEF BENCH –
FILE: 6217.00**

MTI proposes to replace the bridge on Provincial Trunk Highway 5 over the Assiniboine River and modify the riparian floodplain area upstream of the bridge in the Municipality of Glenboro-South Cypress. The proposed bridge will be a larger 172-metre replacement structure that will be supported by two piers. The project will reshape the nearby river channel to reduce the likelihood of closing the highway during future flood events.
