The development includes a 22.3 m x 11.3 m agrichemical warehouse with 15.24 cm retention curbing, bulk liquid fertilizer storage tanks with a total capacity of 113,900 US gallons and blending capabilities, a dry fertilizer facility with six 200 metric ton hopper bottom bins equipped for blending, and two 30,000 US gallon anhydrous ammonia storage vessels. The facility has been in operation for 40 years.
