Re: Environment Act Licence Suspension
Discharge of St. Pierre-Jolys Wastewater Treatment Lagoon

This letter acknowledges your request received on May 5, 2020 to commence discharge of effluent from the wetland cell and the third secondary cell of the Village of St. Pierre-Jolys' wastewater treatment lagoon outside of the discharge period specified by Clause 27(f) of Environment Act Licence Number 802 R.

In your letter you have indicated that the primary and secondary cells are at great and immediate risk of breaching the berms of the facility due to abnormally high precipitation in the fall, and given that there has not been a discharge event from the primary and secondary cells since October 2016. I understand this pause in discharges occurred to facilitate the construction and establishment of the new wetland treatment cell that was brought into service in the fall of 2019. You have also provided laboratory analyses results indicating that wastewater effluent in both the wetland cell and the third secondary cell does not exceed any of the discharge parameters specified by Clause 27.

I am granting a suspension of Clause 27(f) of Environment Act Licence No. 802 R pursuant to Section 18(1) of The Environment Act, which allows you to proceed with the discharge as per your request. The suspension is in effect from May 11th to May 24th 2020, inclusive. All other clauses in Environment Act Licence Number 802 R remain in effect.
