**RE: Environment Act Licence Suspension
Discharge of Highway Gardens Wastewater Treatment Lagoon**

This letter acknowledges the request by the Highway Gardens Ltd. to commence discharge of effluent from the secondary cell of the Highway Gardens Wastewater Treatment Lagoon without meeting the effluent limit for total coliforms as specified in Environment Act Licence 1355.

I am granting a suspension of Clause 4 of Environment Act Licence No. 1355 pursuant to Section 18(1) of The Environment Act which allows you to proceed with the discharge. The suspension is in effect from October 24 to October 31, 2017 inclusive for this event.

Please be advised that if weather conditions become unsuitable, discharge must cease and authorization may be revoked. All other clauses in Environment Act Licence No. 1355 remain in effect.
