Be it resolved that it is imperative that an issuance of a Director's Order, as Director of Parks, by way of section 27(1) of *The Provincial Parks Act*, is necessary to implement specific closures in provincial parks.


Due to significant risks associated with out-of-control wildfires adjacent to and within Atikaki Provincial Park, this new expanded Closure Order applies to the majority of the Park area adjacent to the Ontario border – please see the attached Atikaki Provincial Park Closure Area map.

The closure immediately comes into effect today, Tuesday, July 22nd, 2025.

During the period of the closure, no person should reside in or enter the park closure area unless otherwise authorized by Manitoba Parks.

This Director's Order under *The Provincial Parks Act* is in effect until such time as it is rescinded.

Be it further resolved that the below Director's Order for the closure of Atikaki Provincial Park, as issued on July 9th, 2025, is rescinded once this new Closure Order is effective

The closure will come into effect today, Wednesday, July 9th, 2025, at 5 pm.

During the period of the closure, no person should reside in or enter the park closure area unless otherwise authorized by Manitoba Parks.

This Director's Order under *The Provincial Parks Act* is in effect until such time as it is rescinded.
