**RE: Director's Order – Wekusko Falls Provincial Park Closure and Evacuation**

Be it resolved that it is imperative that an issuance of a Director's Order, as Director of Parks, by way of section 27(1) of *The Provincial Parks Act*, is necessary to implement specific closures in provincial parks.

Due to significant risks associated with out-of-control wildfires adjacent to Wekusko Falls Provincial Park, this closure and evacuation order includes the entire area of the Park – please see the attached Wekusko Falls Provincial Park Closure Area map.

The closure will come into effect today, Thursday, July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 9:00 am.

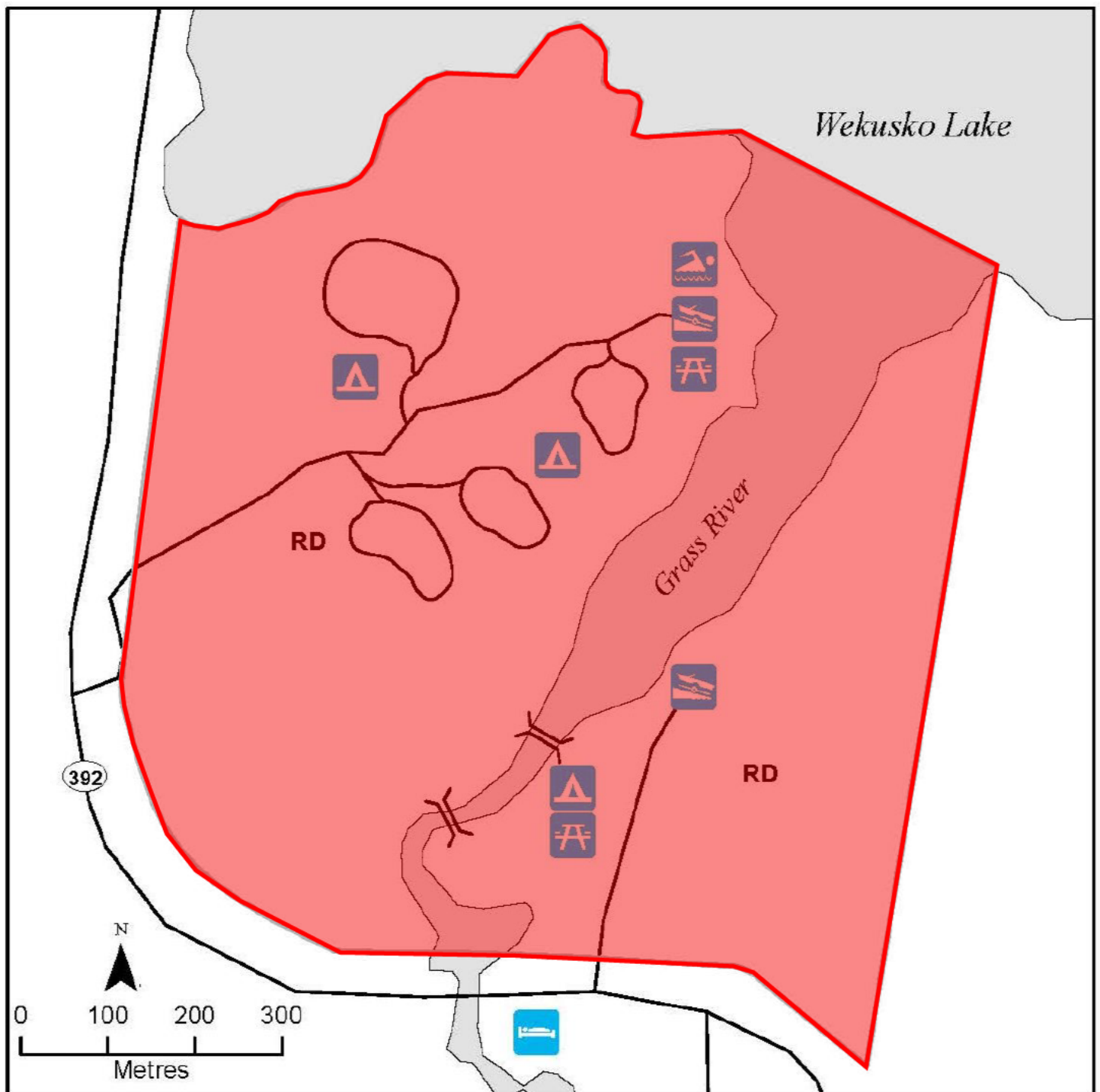
All persons are required to evacuate the closure area by today, Thursday, July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 12:00 noon.

During the period of the closure, no person should reside in or enter the park closure area unless otherwise authorized by Manitoba Parks.

This Director's Order under *The Provincial Parks Act* is in effect until such time as it is rescinded.
