Campground Tips

- Be Wildlife Smart. Do not feed any wildlife, including birds or squirrels. You are in black bear country - secure all attractants such as food, cooking equipment and trash in a locked vehicle. Do not store food or attractants in your tent.
- Practice Leave No Trace. Pack out all gear and trash to keep the campsites clean for others.
- Keep dogs on leash and clean up after your pet.
- Learn to recognize and avoid poisonous plants such as poison ivy.
- Open fires are prohibited. Use portable stoves or fire pits provided.
- Don't Move Firewood - Moving firewood can spread harmful invasive species and destroy our forests.
- Prevent the spread of aquatic invasive species. Always clean, drain, dry watercraft and water related equipment. Visit manitoba.ca/stopais for full regulations.
- In case of injury or illness contact a Park Attendant or Park Patrol Officer. They can assist you to reach medical help.

Open May through September, Hnausa Beach Campground is a quiet, secluded spot on Lake Winnipeg offering five basic sites and 36 electrical sites. Choose a campsite to suit your needs - large and wide, one near the shoreline or on a green, grassy location. Regardless of which one you choose you will never be far from the water.

Hnausa Beach is an ideal location for a peaceful weekend at the lake but also offers opportunity for activity. The children's playground near the sandy beach will provide hours of family fun.

Walk or bike along the old railway to the Hnausa General Store to sample some imported Icelandic foods or take home a souvenir.

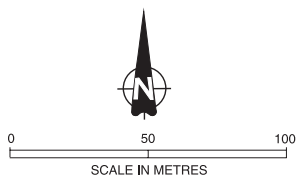
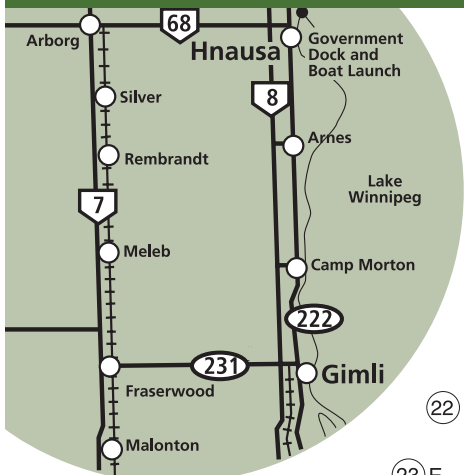
The boat launch is just two kilometers from the campground with a dock area for shore fishing. Bring your tackle box and try catching your night's dinner in the designated fishing area near the beach.

The Hnausa Beach Campground is located in the Interlake, 39 kilometres north of Gimli and 0.6 kilometres south of Hnausa.

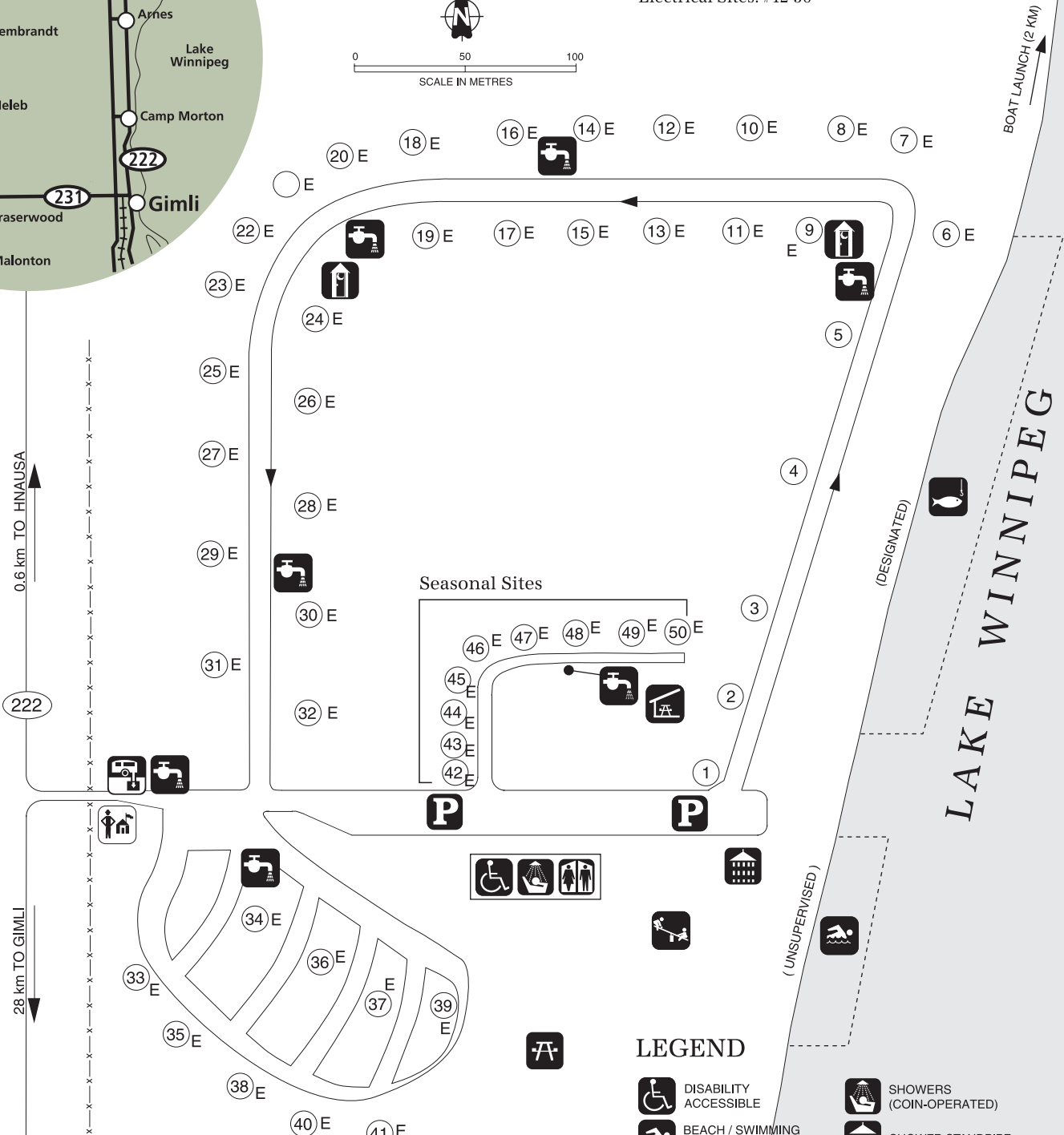
