

Manitoba Parks Facebook Page - Contest Rules

THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO THE 2019 MANITOBA PARKS SUMMER PHOTO CONTEST.

1. **NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.**

2. **Description of contest:**

Win two free nights of camping at a Manitoba provincial park with our Summer Photo Contest. Send us your spring photos from any Manitoba provincial park in a Facebook message to “[MBGovParks](#)” along with the Manitoba provincial park location of the photo. “MBGovParks” Facebook page can be found at: www.facebook.com/MBGovParks. On October 1, 2019, the Administrator will share all eligible photos on the Manitoba Parks Facebook page and randomly choose one winner. This promotion is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Facebook.

By entering this photo contest, entrants agree to accept, abide by and acknowledge compliance with these rules, including but not limited to all eligibility requirements. The decisions of the Administrator (defined in section 3 below) are final and binding on all entrants with respect to all aspect of the photo contest. The photo contest is subject to all applicable federal and provincial laws and regulations. Void where prohibited.

3. **Contest administration and time period:** This photo contest is administered and managed by the Government of Manitoba (the “Administrator”). The contest will take place in Manitoba, Canada from May 17, 2019 to September 30, 2019. A random draw to select the winner will be made at approximately 9 a.m. on October 1, 2019 in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada at the offices of Manitoba Sustainable Development. One entry will be randomly drawn from all the eligible photo entries received during the applicable entry period.
4. **Prizes:** There is one prize available to be won. The prize is a two night camping pass valid for any Manitoba provincial park during the 2020 camping season. The camping pass may be used for non-electric, electric, or backcountry camping sites but may not be used for yurts or cabins. The camping pass must be redeemed at the time of reservation. The approximate retail value of the prize is \$50.00 CAD. Receipt of the prize is subject to these contest rules.

Acceptance of Prize: The prize must be accepted as described in these Contest Rules and cannot be returned, transferred to another individual, substituted for another prize or exchanged in whole or in part for money.

Substitution of Prize: The Administrator reserves the right to substitute any prize, or part thereof, for another prize of equivalent value.

Method of entry: There is no purchase necessary. Each photo must be submitted in a Facebook message to the Manitoba Parks Facebook page (www.facebook.com/MBGovParks). Each photo supplied constitutes one entry into the contest. For purposes of this photo contest, the entrant is the person who is the authorized holder of the Facebook account that enters the photo contest, and has adhered to Facebook Terms of Service - <https://www.facebook.com/terms.php>.

5. **Eligibility:** The contest is open to all Manitobans/Canadians (excluding Quebec) who are at least 16 years of age as of the opening date of the contest. Employees of Manitoba Sustainable Development, agents and representatives are not eligible. All entries must be submitted by a valid Facebook account. Any entrant suspected or found using fake accounts to enter, or found to be in violation of Facebook rules will be ineligible to win a prize.

The Administrator reserves the right to prohibit an individual from participating in the photo contest or winning a prize, if, in its sole discretion, it is determined that the individual is attempting to undermine the legitimate operation of the photo contest.

6. **Eligible Photo Criteria:** In order to be eligible, a photo must:
 - a. be taken in a Manitoba provincial park;
 - b. must not have been published before;
 - c. feature no identifiable individuals.

Each photo received will be reviewed and approved by the Administrator or a representative of the Government of Manitoba. If an entry is in violation of these contest rules, it will be disqualified or deemed 'void'. **The validity of any entry** is subject to verification by the Administrator. Any entries that are illegible, incomplete, fraudulent, misrepresented or otherwise non-compliant with these rules, will be disqualified. All decisions made by the Administrator are final.

7. **Awarding of Prize:** To be declared a winner, a selected entrant must meet the contest eligibility criteria in sections 5 and 6 and be in compliance with these contest rules. The winning entrant must be available for notice by email (at the email address associated with entrant's Facebook account, if available), or by Facebook message – by the Administrator within 7 days immediately following the closing date and time of the contest. Should a selected entrant not respond within 72 hours of the notification or fail to provide proof of eligibility, his/her entry may be declared null and void and another entry will be randomly selected from the remaining entries.
8. **Delivery of Prize:** The entrant must attend Manitoba Sustainable Development office at 200 Saulteaux Crescent, Winnipeg, Manitoba, to claim their prize and do the following:
 - a. show photo ID to prove identity, age and validity of their Facebook account
 - b. declare ownership of the photo submitted
 - c. sign a declaration and release letter (in the event that the selected entrant is under 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must sign and claim the prize on their behalf).

Following receipt and acceptance of the above prize delivery criteria, the Administrator will provide the winner with their prize, in person.

9. **Administrator Disclaimers:**
 - a. The Administrator is not responsible for, and will not replace any prizes that are lost, stolen or damaged.
 - b. The Administrator is not responsible or liable for unsuccessful attempts to notify selected entrants or for entries or declaration and release forms which are delayed, lost, stolen, illegible, damaged, misdirected, postage due or incomplete.
 - c. The Administrator is not responsible for lost, late, or damaged entries due to internet, computer, phone, other technical errors, or any situation that may limit an individual's ability to participate in the photo contest.

10. **Grant of License:** By submitting a photo and entering the contest, entrants grant the Government of Manitoba a license to use, distribute, and publish the entrant's photograph without further permission. By entering the Contest, the entrant authorizes the Administrator, along with its advertising and promotional agencies and their respective employees to broadcast, publish, reproduce and otherwise use their photograph without any form of remuneration.
11. **Odds of Winning:** Odds of winning the prize is dependant upon the number of eligible entries received.
12. **Changes to Contest Rules:** The Administrator reserves the right to modify, cancel, terminate or suspend the Contest, in whole or in part, in the event of any cause that is beyond the control of the Administrator including any virus, computer bug, hack or unauthorized intervention or, any other cause that is beyond the control of the Administrator that could corrupt or affect the administration, security, impartiality or normal course of the Contest.
13. **Release of Liability by the Entrants:** By entering into this Contest, all entrants agree to release any claims, damages, demands, suits, duties, debts, bonds, contract and liabilities of any nature against the Administrator, its representatives, the Government of Manitoba and its employees and agents. Winners must complete the requirements of section 8 above to claim their prize.

Privacy Notice: Personal information collected in the photo contest by the Administrator will be collected and used solely for the purpose of administering the photo contest, in accordance with clause 36(1)(b) of *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, C.C.S.M. c. F175. The Administrator will not send communications unrelated to the photo contest to the entrant. The Administrator will maintain any personal information that it collects on its servers and it will only be accessible to those responsible for maintaining the "MBGovParks" Facebook page and administering the photo contest. Personal information will only be stored until the prize has been awarded. All entrants may access any personal information they provided to the Administrator through the course of entering the photo contest and request amendment of any inaccuracies.
