KELSEY GENERATING STATION – SHORT TERM EXTENSION LICENCE


We request renewal of the Short Term Extension Licence (STEL) for Kelsey Generating Station under the provisions of Section 92(6) of Water Power Regulation 25/88R. We request that the STEL be renewed for an additional five-year term. The first STEL was issued on December 12, 2014. The supporting documentation provided at that time is still valid. A second STEL was issued on December 19, 2019 and a third STEL on December 23, 2024.

Manitoba Hydro applied for the renewal of the Final Licence for Kelsey on December 17, 2010 and submitted supporting technical requirements on March 3, 2020.

Manitoba Hydro continues to operate the Kelsey Generating Station in compliance with the third STEL. Ongoing compliance with the licence is documented in our Annual Water Levels and Flows Compliance Report.
