Under the Dangerous Goods Handling and Transportation Act, Section 30(1), you are hereby ordered to complete a gasoline vapor and gasoline plume delineation at the Petro Canada station addressed at 208 St. Anne's Road in Winnipeg, Manitoba. The vapor and gasoline plumes shall show zero closure around their circumferences so that the extent of the product and vapor migration can be established. This order is effective immediately and shall be completed by June 9, 1989.
