Re: Remedial Action Plan for Maple Leaf Construction Equipment Yard, 1600 Erin Street, Winnipeg, Manitoba

This will acknowledge receipt of the Proposed Remedial Action Plan dated August 2, 2002 prepared by KGS Group Inc. for the remediation of petroleum hydrocarbon contaminated soil at the property described above.

The Remedial Action Plan proposes to excavate and remove petroleum hydrocarbon contaminated soil from the site for treatment and disposal at the Petroleum Contaminated Soil Treatment Facility at 2245 Brookside Boulevard. Because of the volume of soil at the site, the work will be staged over a four year period, beginning in the fall of 2002 and finishing in 2006.

It is the position of Manitoba Conservation that the remediation of the contaminated soil located at 1600 Erin Street in Winnipeg, Manitoba be undertaken as proposed.

KGS is required to provide Manitoba Conservation with advance notice prior to initiating excavation activities at the site. KGS is also required to provide an annual report on remedial activities and a final closure report at the completion of all remedial activities. If you have any questions regarding these requirements, please do not hesitate to contact the undersigned.

It should be noted that the position of Manitoba Conservation as stated in this letter is based on the information provided to this office by KGS Group Inc. and relates only to the matters within the scope of the investigation conducted by KGS Group Inc. No additional site monitoring was performed by Manitoba Conservation.
