This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of April 9, 1994 and report dated 08/04/94, on the preliminary site investigation of the property described above.

Based on the information provided in this report, there is evidence that some soils around BH6, BH10, TP2 and TP3 exceed the CCME Commerical/Industrial criteria for Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (PAH's). The report also indicates that Boron levels around TP1, TP2, TP3, BH11 and MW1 exceed the CCME Commercial/Indstrial criteria. Levels of Sulphur found in TP2 and TP3 exceed the CCME Agricultural criteria.

I have directed your letter "Preliminary Underground Storage Tank (UST) Investigation at the Sutherland Avenue Operations Facility" to Mr. Maurice Mazerolle in our office. Please contact Mr. Maurice Mazerolle at 945-7110 with respect to the removal of the tank.

As indicated by your letter of April 9, 1994, a file has been created for this site, however the information will remain confidential pending receipt and dicussion with Centra Gas of the Phase II Assessment Report.
