Re: Status of PAH Impacted Soil at Mid Canada Soil Treatment Ltd. Site From Centra Gas, Sutherland & Annabella Facility

This letter acknowledges receipt of your report, dated October 18, 1996, with respect to the aforementioned site. The report describes the results of soil analyses for PAH compounds, in determining the suitability of use of these soils as cover material for municipal solid waste at the Sanford waste disposal ground.

Based on the results of the laboratory analyses conducted, the soil appears to contain concentrations of PAH compounds which fall below the CCME criteria for commercial/industrial sites, which are the appropriate criteria for disposal of the soil at the Sanford waste disposal ground.

It is the position of Manitoba Environment that the soil in question, as assessed by the recovery and analyses of six soil samples from the soil stockpile, can be used as cover material at the adjacent Sanford waste disposal ground facility.
