
Re: Groundwater Remediation and Intrinsic Bioremediation Sutherland

This will acknowledge receipt of the letters, dated October 15, 1996, prepared by AGRA Earth and Environmental Limited on containment and remediation of the shallow groundwater at the property described above.

Mr. Rick Lemoine and I have reviewed the information and concur with the AGRA's conclusion that the site hydrochemical conditions be fully assessed and the feasibility testing for intrinsic bioremediation be undertaken prior to the development of a detailed Remedial Action Plan. In this regard, we would like to be kept apprised of the assessment and feasibility work on an on-going basis. We have also noted that AGRA's recommendation to classify and quantify microbial populations in the groundwater will not be reflective of the substrate biomass.
