Reference: The City of Winnipeg Water and Waste Department – 2002 Outfall Gate Chamber Upgrades – Tender No. 620-2002

Enclosed for your review and comments is one (1) set of drawings for the above noted project.

The work scheduled for the Disraeli Street site as shown on Drawings CW-01-614 and CW-07-614 will take place in an area that has been previously identified as containing petroleum hydrocarbon contaminated soil. This work involves the installation of a new manhole including a gate valve and a flap gate for flood control purposes on an existing 300-mm land drainage sewer outfall. The manhole will be located southwest of the corner of Disraeli Street and Rover Avenue. The existing sewer at this location is approximately four meters below existing grade at this location. Following installation at this location the grade immediately surrounding the manhole will be raised approximately one meter to meet 300-year flood elevations.

At this site the remedial action plan will follow procedures already established for work in the Boyle/Syndicate Combined Sewer District at this location as outlined in the Remedial Action Plan submitted to Manitoba Conservation on October 20, 2000 and approved on November 15, 2000. In general the plan proposes to excavate and remove for disposal at an approved off-site location, all soil impacted with petroleum hydrocarbons encountered during the construction work.

The project is scheduled for tender around the end of September 2002. We would appreciate it if we could receive your comments no later than September 20, 2002.
