Re: <u>SW 09-25-22 W, Gilbert Plains, Manitoba;</u> <u>Revocation of Designation under the Contaminated Sites Remediation Act</u>

This letter is to advise you that the designation of the above-noted property (the site) as an impacted site, has been revoked under section 7.2(1) of The Contaminated Sites Remediation Act, C.C.S.M, c. C205.

Manitoba Conservation and Climate also acknowledges receipt of the report entitled "Phase II Environmental Site Assessment, Gilbert Plains Cardlock Facility, SW-09-25-22 W1M, near Gilbert Plains, Manitoba" prepared by Trace Associates Inc. dated April 1, 2020 for the above-noted property (the site).

Manitoba Conservation and Climate concurs that the report submitted adequately documents the environmental site conditions at the site at this time.

It is the position of Manitoba Conservation and Climate that no further remediation is required on this site at this time. In the event that any residual contamination remaining on the site results in some form of exposure concern in the future, the responsible party will be directed by this department to initiate any remedial measures.

It should be noted that the position of Manitoba Conservation and Climate as stated in this letter is based on the information provided to this office by Trace Associates Inc. and relates only to the matters within the scope of the investigation that was conducted by Trace Associates Inc. No additional site monitoring was performed by Manitoba Sustainable Development.
