Re: Bulk Plant DeCommissioning

The soil excavation recommended by Federated Cooperative Ltd. and carried out this past summer by Jim's Pump Service was successful in reducing hydrocarbon concentrations to acceptable levels along the west, south and east perimeter of the excavation. Lab analysis of representative soil samples confirm this result.

Because the location of the railway adjacent to your property prevented soil removal and remediation along the north perimeter, some contamination remained in that area.

The likelihood of the remaining contamination impacting subsurface structures or domestic water supplies (ground water) in the area is thought to be minimal. However, any wells in the vicinity should be identified and their location recorded with our office.

If there is no identified risk to surrounding properties the remaining contaminants may be left on site. The objective will be to manage risk associated with the remaining hydrocarbon levels. This may involve some future monitoring.

The site will continue to be identified as a contaminated property of the Department in order to ensure that the condition is considered in any future development.
