Watershed Residents,

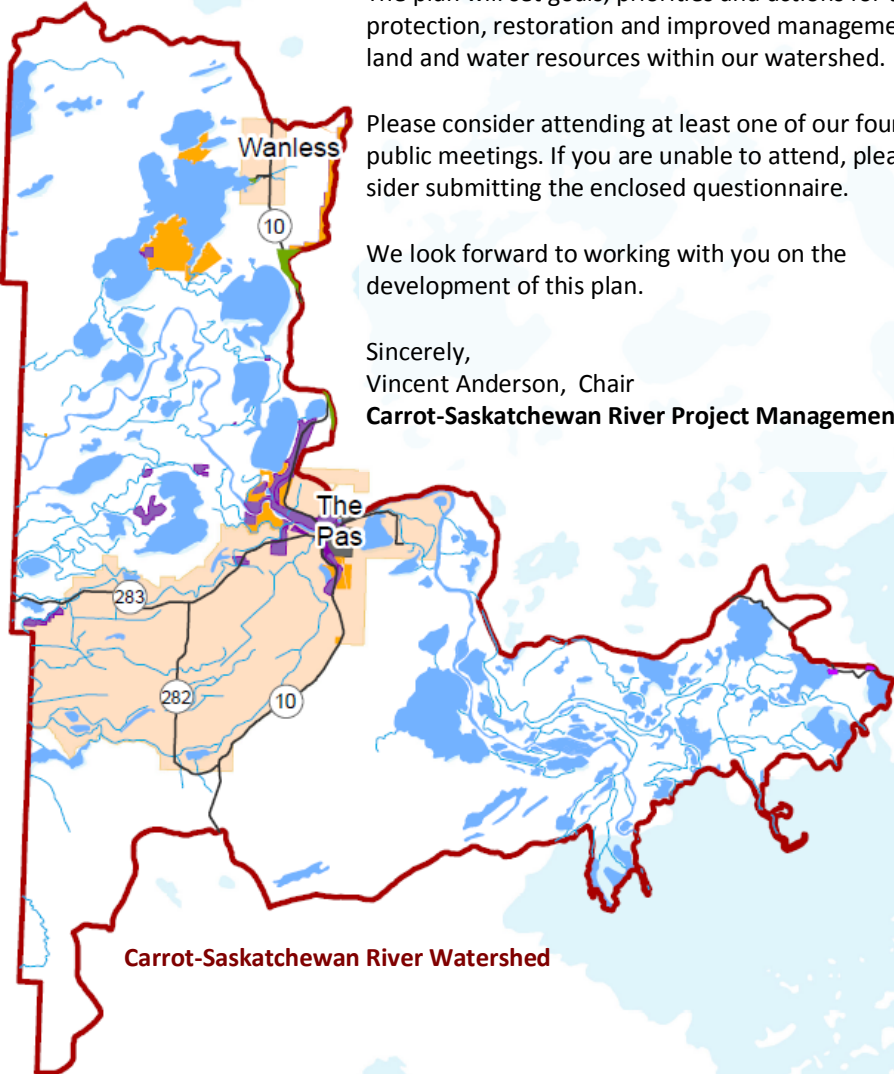
