BACKGROUND

In May 1998, a process was initiated by the Province of Manitoba's Energy and Mines department (now Manitoba Industry, Trade and Mines) to bring together representatives of First Nations, Metis Nation, Northern Communities and the Manitoba Minerals Industry to begin a relationship building process. The purpose of this process continues to be to strengthen the links between parties, learn about common aspirations, cultural values and communication needs, and to create a climate for mutually beneficial opportunities related to the building of a strong minerals industry* within Manitoba.
