Persons working in the trades of Hairstylist, Esthetician and Electrologist must have an Authorization to Practise to legally work in Manitoba.

A Temporary Authorization to Practise is granted to a person who has:

- i. Paid the prescribed \$15.00 fee AND
- ii. Been approved to take a prescribed examination; or
- iii. Been approved to proceed through the Trades Qualification process; or
- iv. Is applying to re-instate his or her Authorization to Practice and is undertaking upgrading as required by the Executive Director of Apprenticeship Manitoba

Trades Qualification Applicants

Trades Qualification applicants in the trades of Hairstylist, Esthetician or Electrologist, must include this application (Temporary Authorization to Practise) with your Trades Qualification Application form and the prescribed \$100 Trades Qualification fee. A Temporary Authorization to Practise will be issued only if your Trades Qualification Application is approved.
