Based upon the legal authority granted under The Apprenticeship and Certification Act, if the Director of Apprenticeship Manitoba is of the opinion that the holder of a Certificate of Qualification provided false or misleading information, he/she may cancel or suspend the certificate of qualification. I understand that a person who knowingly contravenes a provision of the above Act is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction is liable to pay a fine of not more than \$10,000. I understand that, under the authority of The Statistics Act (Canada), Apprenticeship Manitoba shares identifying personal information with Statistics Canada to conduct statistical surveys with individuals, reports and information produced by Statistics Canada from these surveys do not identify any individual or individuals. I understand that Apprenticeship Manitoba may share non-identifying bulk information with Statistics Canada and other Canadian provinces and territories to maintain national statistics and records. Personal information is protected by The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
