Who can participate?

You may participate if you are unemployed or working less than an average of 20 hours per week.

- Employment plan development
- Employment counselling
- Assessment services
- Information on the labour market and education/training opportunities
- Resume assistance
- Job search assistance
- Job finding clubs
- Job referral and/or placement
