Additional Employment Services

Additional employment services are available at our Centres and through partnerships with community and employer groups. These services may be available to those who meet eligibility criteria.

Additional employment services include:

- skills training/upgrading assistance
- job placement
- pre-employment preparation
- work experience/training placements
- training for self-employment
- work placement with wage subsidy
- apprenticeship training assistance
- financial assistance

Eligibility Criteria

We review your request for assistance in relation to your skills, current circumstances, the needs of the labour market and service priorities. You may be eligible if you fit into one of the following categories:

- Unemployed or working less than an average of 20 hours/week
- Have a current or previous Employment Insurance (EI) claim
- Employed individuals who are low skilled or a lower income individual or family with dependent child(ren)
- An individual who is about to lose their job

We contract with community organizations to offer a variety of short-term employment-related services.
