

Professional Immigrant Pilot (PIP) Project Employment Manitoba

This pilot project assists skilled/professional immigrants to enter their field of expertise in the Canadian labour market.

Who can participate?

People will be considered if they:

- are permanent residents and legally entitled to work in Canada,
- are able to read, write, listen to and speak English on a professional level (ESL Benchmark Level 7 preferred),
- have education/experience in profession being pursued from their home country, and
- have a career development plan that leads to employment in an area of high demand/skill shortages.

Applications will be reviewed on an individual basis to determine eligibility.
